The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 69.7 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 26.1% of the 166,062 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 50.6%, renter occupied; and 23.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 142,801 housing units in the area - 24.1% owner occupied, 50.7% renter occupied, and 25.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 6.94%. Median home value in the area is \$325,671, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.82% annually to \$356,404.
